Home learning encompasses two key components:

- x Homework: Teacher directed learning tasks. This can include completion of class work, assignments, practice questions and reading of novel chapters.
- x Study: Student directed learning. This includes revision, previewing information, è X ô Í e 2 Ù ² Í \and èrfiið maps, summarising key ideas and independent practice tasks.

Home learning guidelines Middle years (7, 8 and 9)

Homework

The key focusof homework in the middle years is to support literacy and numeracy skills. The key homework tasks set should be:

- x Math Pathways modules.
- x Reading a chapter of a novel for English.

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Senior years (Year 10, 11 and 12)

Homework

Teachers are likely to set regular homework tasks. These teacheirected tasks can include:

- **x** Pre-reading or previewing content prior to learning a topic in class.
- x Practice questions to consolidate classroom learning.
- x Completing assignments or research tasks.
- x Reading books, articles, or textbooks to support classroom learning.

Study

Students should be doing this regularly to help remember and revietine concepts covered in class. Study strategies students could utiliseinclude:

- x Self-directed completion of practice exam-style questions.

- x Writing summaries of what has been covered.
- x Creating glossaries
